Congratulations on being cast in Dripping Spring Middle School's 2008 spring musical production *Oklahoma!*. Each actor and technician plays an integral part in the overall production and must therefore display commitment to the project as a whole. In order to remain a participant, you must follow the general rules for rehearsal and maintain the following:

1. Grades: It is your responsibility to manage your time wisely so that you are still able to finish your homework even though you have rehearsals in the afternoon. Grades come first. If you find that you are failing your classes, there is a risk of being removed from the show
2. Behavior at rehearsals (consult "General Rules" sheet): It is very important that your behavior at rehearsals be as good as possible. This allows the other actors to get the maximum amount of work done. It is also important that we respect the school property. If you are continually distracting during the rehearsal process, you will be removed from the show.
3. Behavior outside of rehearsal: Likewise, if we find that you are causing problems in your classes, a conference will be held with your teachers to determine the best actions to take in order to correct the problem. If the problems are habitual, you may be removed from the show.
4. Attendance at rehearsal: You will not be called to every rehearsal. It is your responsibility to email notification at least 24 hours in advance if you are unable to make it ([tara.tower@dripping-springs.txed.net](mailto:tara.tower@dripping-springs.txed.net)). If you are absent when we stage a dance, musical number or scene, you may be cut from that section. However, if you "skip" a rehearsal or show, you will be removed from the program. You must submit a conflict sheet in order to participate. You must check the website daily in case there are changes or important information. **www.dstigerchoir.com.**
